

Career of the Month



Medical (diagnostic) radiographers operate x-ray machines, ultrasound, magnetic resonance imaging and other imaging devices for diagnostic and therapeutic purposes, assist in the diagnosis of injuries and diseases and are involved in intervention procedures such as the removal of kidney stones. They operate under the supervision of senior staff.

To become a radiographer, you must first complete a degree course, complete an approved programme in diagnostic radiography and be registered with the health and care professions council (HCPC). To earn more you could consider either becoming a radiologist, as the average annual salary is much greater. Average Salary: £43,573.06




