Dear Parents and Carers

Here at Rye Hills Academy, we are helping your children to make carefully considered choices about the subjects they wish to study in the next phase of their education, in order to help them to reach their goals and aspirations for the future.

With this in mind, over the next three weeks your son/daughter will attend a series of assemblies where they will receive information about the Key Stage 4 Options process. This will include information about the whole process as well as presentations from subject leaders about the different option subjects. The first of these took place on Friday 11th March.

This will be followed by the Key Stage 4 Options Evening, on Wednesday 30th March between 5.00pm and 7.00pm.

Senior staff and subject teachers in school are keen to discuss GCSE and Vocational/ Technical courses and options with both students and parents. It is important that students make informed and careful decisions, so I hope you will take the opportunity to visit the school for the KS4 Options Evening with your son/daughter on **Wednesday 30th March 2022**.

During the evening there will be a presentation in the Main Hall explaining all that there is to know about the options process. This is so that parents can hear the same information given to the students.
