

This is where we house extra resources for every subject your child has. You can find details of what they are currently studying this term, along with useful documents such as knowledge organisers.




How do you log on to Student Pod?


- Log in to Office 365.
- You can login to Office 365 by using the link at the top right of our school website.
- Alternatively, you can google 'Office 365 login'



- Use the Office 365 logins you have been given at school. Parents can use your logins to access Student Pod.



- When you have signed into Office 365, click on the 9 dots to bring up the Apps.
- Locate the App called SharePoint and click on it.





- On SharePoint find Student Pod.



At the top of the page is a search bar.

Type in 'POD' to search for Student POD if you have never visited it before.




Click the site link that appears like this that says 'Rye Hills Student POD'

Log in via EASI

- You can login to Student Pod via the EASI link in the top right hand corner of the school website.




- You will then be taken to the EASI home page.




- Click on the Student Pod button, circled above.

- It is filled with lots of resources to help you with your lessons.




- Click the 'follow' star at the top to bookmark it and make visiting POD quicker next time.



Accessing SharePoint & Student Pod using an app on your device.

Accessing student POD using the SharePoint app is very similar to the website.



Open the app, and type POD in the search bar. Click on Rye Hills Student Pod



Then, click the three lines on the left hand side to take you to your year group.
